Around the age of twenty-one Jean was moved to a group home at 101 Kelly's Court in Forest City, Iowa where she lived the rest of her life.

Jean participated in the Iowa Special Olympics and received ribbons and medals. She enjoyed going for car rides with her parents, field trips, the local fair, shopping trips and visits to the homes of staff members. She loved animals, children, Mountain Dew, Culver's fish sandwich and strawberry shakes. She also loved spicy foods and shoe shopping like her mom. She enjoyed music, especially her dad playing the piano, TV shows like the Golden Girls and she enjoyed the Grotto of West Bend with her family when she was a child and then later on as an adult with her Forest City family. She was loved by many and will be missed.

Jean Elizabeth Crabtree is survived by her siblings: Jerald L. (Phyllis) Peet, Rose M. (Myron) Meester and Teri A. (Kris) Kinney as well as many aunts, uncles, nieces, nephews and cousins. She is also survived by her Forest City group home family.
